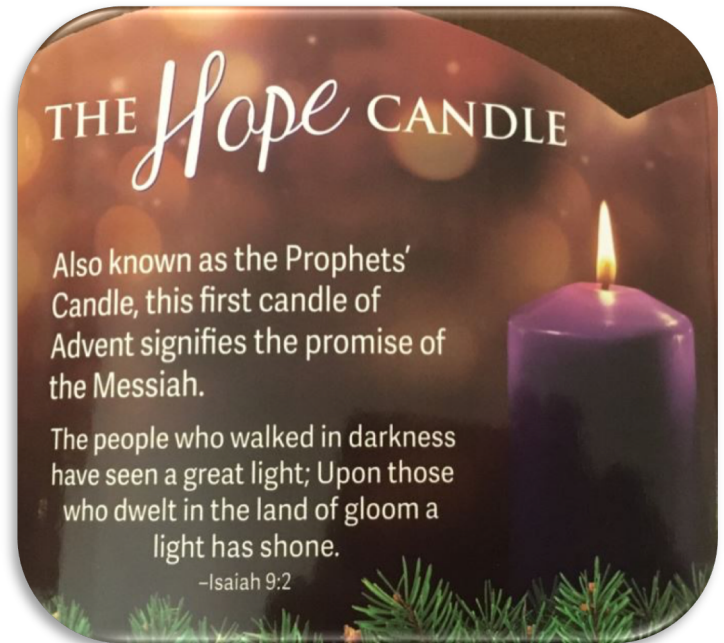

### ***A reflection on St. Andrew Our Patron***

“Rabbi, where are you staying?” Jesus responded immediately to this question of *Andrew* and the other disciple, saying, “Come, and you will see”. That clear invitation foreshadowed the following, more explicit call Jesus made on the shore of the Sea of Galilee to Simon, “Come follow me, and I will make you fishers of men”. The two disciples were still taken aback, but did not have any hesitation following Jesus, as the evangelist Matthew writes, “At once they left their nets and followed him”. From that first exchange with each other, a journey of faith began in following Jesus in his daily ministry. *Andrew* is one of the twelve apostles, whom the Son of God chose as one of his closest friends.” *Taken from vaticannews.va*
