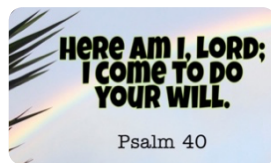

 THE WORD OF GOD



Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter, "Aperuit Illis" published on September 30, 2019, established that, "the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (Jan.22nd, this year) is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God".

Pope Francis is inviting Catholics across the world to deepen their appreciation, love and faithful witness to God and his Word.

This is an initiative that the Pope has entrusted to the whole Church so that "the Christian community may concentrate on the great value that the Word of God occupies in its daily existence" (Aperuit illis 2).

By establishing this Day, the Pope intended "to respond to the many requests that have come from the people of God, so that throughout the Church the Sunday of the Word of God may be celebrated in unity of purpose".

He underlined the great ecumenical value that this Sunday possesses as it falls close to the Day of Dialogue between Jews and Catholics and the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.

"This Sunday, he wants to stimulate all Christians not just to place the Bible on the shelf as one of many books, perhaps filled with dust, but as an instrument that awakens our faith."
